

You should now be able to see the list of documents relating to the fund you are applying for. Select the download button, which will save a zip file to your device. Please ensure you read and understand all guidelines and guidance notes prior to applying for any funding.

This is where most problems occur, to find where the documents are saved rely upon you knowing your device and where your downloads are saved. This is not a fault of the document not downloading as it will be on your device.

To troubleshoot we have found that documents downloaded are *usually* saved in the following places (links have also been provided to help you) :
